### COVID-19 Code of Conduct

As the Dearborn Public Library begins a phased return to open hours, the health and safety of the entire community is our top priority. The library has implemented several new steps to help mitigate exposure to the virus. This document will serve as an addendum to the Library Code of Conduct.

All visitors must comply with the following health and safety requirements when visiting:

- Each visitor will be greeted at the entrance, have their temperature taken and be required to fill out a Visitor Health Screening Form
- Masks must be worn at all times and must cover the nose and mouth; vented masks are not permissible
- Persons not from the same household must remain 6 feet apart from each other
- The Library retains the option to limit group size
- Visits are limited to one (1) hour per day
- Computer use is limited to a single one-hour session per day
- One person per table; no rearrangement of furniture
- The auditorium, meeting rooms and study booths are not available for use
- Patrons are encouraged to use hand sanitizer and/or wash hands frequently
- The library reserves the right to refuse entry for any reason
